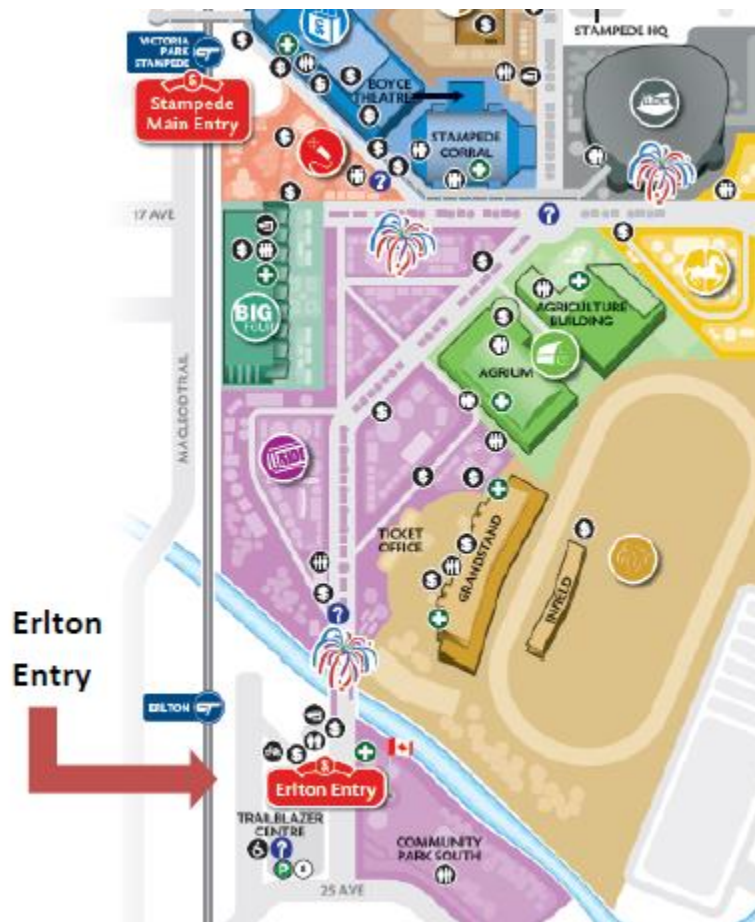




**Regional Cadet Support Unit (NW)

Grandstand Information 11 July 2017:

Arrive at **Erlton Entrance** of the Stampede



Arrival Times:

Arrival for ***CalStampGS1*** is NO LATER THAN (NLT) **1115hrs**

Arrival for ***CalStampGS2*** is NLT **1815hrs**

Cadets will receive their passes and at 1130hrs or 1830hrs everyone will walk together over to the South Tower.

The afternoon shift will start between 11:45/12:00 and last until approximately 13:30. The rodeo finishes at 16:00, and the Cadets are free to watch the rodeo afterward, as their passes grant them standing room in the Grandstand.

The evening shift will start between 18:45/19:00 and last until approximately 20:30. The chuckwagons finish at 21:20 and are followed by the Grandstand Show, which lasts until approximately 23:00. Again, the Cadets are welcome to watch both the chuckwagons and the Grandstand Show with their standing room passes.
